STUDENT SUBMISSIONS – ENTRY INFORMATION

DEADLINE: Wednesday, September 1, 2011, 4:30 pm.

Eligibility:

Student Submissions are for filmmakers (Kindergarten – College) who would like their film to be considered for programming in the 6th Annual Central Wisconsin Film Festival (*cwfilmfest*), November 4th, 5th and 6th 2011, and who will not be submitting films via the Student Submissions. See www.cwfilmfest.org for detailed description of OPEN and STUDENT SUBMISSIONS.

Student Submissions Rules:

- **Short Film category:** films 2-30 minutes in length. No trailers, and credits are to be no longer than 1 minute.
- **Full length category:** films 1 – 2 hours in length. No trailers.
- **Types of Films Accepted:** Narrative, documentary, experimental, or animated films. Films in or with prior limited commercial release, theatrical exhibition, commercial TV broadcast or webcast, or limited commercial video distribution will be considered. *Cwfilmfest* will NOT consider commercials or advertisements, educational, industrial, medical or informational films, video games or new media games.
- Because *cwfilmfest* is being promoted to the general public, the Arts Alliance of Portage County, Inc. anticipates families with children will attend. **Submissions should address controversial topics in a professional manner. Submissions cannot be sexually explicit, portray images that demean or are violent toward any person, gender, race, ethnic group or animals, or use extreme levels of profanity.**
- **Parental Release:** Student entrants under the age of 18 must send in a completed *Parental Release Form*.
- **Other Festival Exhibition:** Entries that have been shown in other festivals or in limited non-commercial exhibitions are eligible. Preference is given to films without significant exposure in Wisconsin markets prior to the *cwfilmfest*.
- **Entries previously submitted** to the *cwfilmfest* **will not** be considered.
- **Film Completion Date:** Film entries submitted must have been completed within the previous year from submissions date.
- **Formats Accepted:** All submission must be High Quality DVDs with no trailers. You will be contacted if a second DVD is required upon acceptance to the *cwfilmfest*. Materials will not be returned.
- **Screening Rights:** All submitted materials become the property of *cwfilmfest* and Arts Alliance of Portage County, Inc., with exclusive Central Wisconsin showing rights from date of receipt through December 2011. In addition, *cwfilmfest* reserves rights for ONE additional educational screening in early 2012 of selected films to expand our rural outreach mission. Filmmakers can opt out of this by checking the appropriate box on the entry form.
- **Copyrights:** For each submitted work, entrants are responsible for providing in writing all necessary rights and permission documents for the legal *cwfilmfest* exhibition of their entry. For example: music, graphics, copyright materials... Usual protocol is to contact the publisher of copyright material for release permission.
- **Number of Submissions:** More than one entry is acceptable, but **each entry must have** a separate entry form and fee.
- **Award Recognition:** All submissions are entered in the Central Wisconsin Film Festival Audience Choice Awards.
- **Final Decisions:** By submitting their film, entrants agree to abide by the final decisions of *cwfilmfest* programmers.

All *cwfilmfest* publicity is handled through the Arts Alliance of Portage County offices. We hope you will be available for media interviews if requested; you will be contacted by us or the media directly if the opportunity arises.

Filmmakers (director, producers, writers, etc.) are invited to attend the *cwfilmfest*. There may be the possibility to participate in a post-film Q&A. **Please be sure to list your preferred contact information on the *Submission Entry Form*** and whether you would be willing to participate in a Q&A. Unfortunately, funds are not available to sponsor your attendance.

- **Tickets**

We are excited about having your film in the *cwfilmfest*, and that you may want to attend along with crew, family, and friends. Each film maker will receive **TWO** complimentary Weekend Pass Tickets for the festival. These will be sent with your acceptance letter. Additional tickets are available for purchase at the start of each screening. Tickets are required.

STUDENT SUBMISSION CHECKLIST

ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE:

- Completed and signed Entry Form for each entry submitted.
- Certification of Entrant/Contact for each entry submitted.
- Student Entrants paying the Student Submission Rate must submit documentation of Student Status – include the name of school you are attending PLUS a copy of your school ID or other verification of attendance.
- Parental Release Form (If under the age of 18)
- Entry fee of \$5 (check or money order ONLY) for each entry submitted. Made payable to **Arts Alliance of Portage County, Inc.**
- A high quality DVD, no trailers. Only one entry per DVD. Mark name of film/filmmaker clearly on the case and the DVD.
- Word document of film synopsis (no more than 7 sentences), principal cast and crew list, and brief filmmaker bios.
- At least one still photo from the film for publicity purposes. High resolution (minimum 300 dpi) TIFF (preferred), or JPG files, size at least 3 x 5 at 300 dpi.
- Copyright release documentation.
